WIRING INSTRUCTIONS

⚠ WARNING To prevent electrocution, make sure the cable is not connected to a power source before installing a device. Failure to comply with the following instructions could cause an electrical failure or fire.

- Back out the recessed screws on the front face and separate the sections.
- 2. Slide the housing over the cord.
- Strip the cable jacket 1-1/8" and strip each of the wires 5/8". Make sure the wire is clean and a bright copper color. Do not solder the ends of the wire.
- 4. Fully insert each wire under the clamp of the appropriate wire terminal. Make certain there is not wire insulation under any terminal clamp. Tighten the screw clamps to 20 in-lbs of torque. Do not over tighten.
- Recouple the two sections then tighten down the recessed screws with moderate torque.
- Tighten the cord clamp by tightening the two assembly screws to 16-20 in-lbs of torque.
